Jurying will take place in late July and the exhibition will be held at TAP Centre for Creativity in London, Ontario from August 21 - September 7, 2024.

The entry fee covers return postage of the prints. If the fee is not paid, the works will not be submitted to the Jury for consideration. If the fee is not paid, Print London will not return the works and they will become the property of Print London.

All works submitted for exhibition must be for sale. I understand that Print London will charge a 30% commission on the selling price as indicated by the artist on the entry form labels. All works should have a minimum selling price of \$75.

The names of all participants selected for the exhibition and all prize winners will be published on the exhibition website at printlondon.ca.

Print London cannot be held responsible for works damaged or lost during transit.

Print London agrees to take good care of work submitted for exhibition, however, the organizers assume no responsibility for any damage or loss that may occur.

Print London may reproduce works for exhibition promotional purposes.

All prints not selected for the exhibition or not sold during the exhibition will be returned within three months from the closing date of the exhibition at no additional cost to the artist.

In the event of the sale of an artist's print(s), a cheque will be mailed to the artist along with any remaining prints.

The entry package should contain:

- The completed entry form
- Duplicate labels for each work (one attached to each print)
- The works being presented to the jury
- Confirmation of payment of the entry fee

## PACKING / MAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- All entries must be packaged in 8 1/2" x 11" plastic sheet protectors. Print London reserves the right to refuse any entries that are not packaged according to these requirements.
- Cut 2 pieces of cardboard/ foam core/ corrugated plastic, or something rigid (the more lightweight the better for postage costs). The 2 pieces should be the same size, slightly larger than your plastic sheet protectors. Sheet protectors may be folded to fit the works.
- Tape your plastic sleeve(s) by the corners on to one piece of cardboard and tape the other piece on top, sandwiching your prints between them.
- Wrap the cardboard in brown paper, or use an envelope.
