#### INTRODUCTION

In this fourth edition of The Ontario Miniature Print Exhibition (TOMPE2022), Print London is pleased to welcome submissions from across Canada for the first time. Formerly only open to Ontario artists, this edition marks an important departure for this biennial show of contemporary printmaking.

Incredibly, we received over 250 submissions from 75 artists in a variety of media ranging from traditional mediums (lithography, relief, intaglio, and silkscreen) to digital print, vitreography, and 3-D print and many mixed techniques. Artists were invited to submit up to four works each. The three Jurors were tasked with selecting the works that would be exhibited at Satellite Project Space in London ON as well as the prize-winning works. Their task was daunting, but after close examination of all of the works presented and much discussion, they decided to show 95 works from 60 artists. These artists are residents of Alberta, British Columbia, Ontario, Nova Scotia, Newfoundland, and Quebec, a wonderful cross-section of what is happening on the national professional printmaking scene at this time.

We would like to heartily thank the Jurors, as well as our sponsors who have made this exhibition possible. In particular, we extend our thanks to the London Arts Council for their support through the City of London's Community Arts Investment Program, as well as Museum London, Satellite Project Space, and Fanshawe College for their continued support of Print London's programming.
